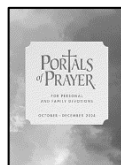


CHURCH OFFERING ENVELOPES

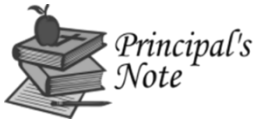
