## Confirmation Essay 8<sup>th</sup> Grade

As a Confirmand who will soon be Confirmed it is important that you are able to express the Christian faith in a more personal way. This project is designed to help you write an essay expressing their personal faith in Jesus Christ which will also be presented in a public setting. Use this worksheet as a guide to putting together an essay.

- 1. Belief statements write out brief statements about what you believe about God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Write out 6-10 statements about what you believe. (examples provided to get you started but please come up with several more statements in your own words.)
  - I believe God, the Father, has made me and all things
  - I believe Jesus Christ is my Savior
  - I believe the Holy Spirit works in my life
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- **2.** God speaks to us in His Word, the Bible. It is through the God's Word that we learn who God is and of His love for each of us. Choose several Bible verses (2-3) that are meaningful to you and support your belief statements.
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- **3.** Choose **one** Bible verse(s) that has the most meaning/impact to you and for which you can share with others.
  - a. Write out the verse(s)

- b. Do some study of the verse(s)
  - i. Background information of the verse(s)
  - ii. How does it share Law and Gospel?
  - iii. What about this verse has special meaning to you?
- 4. Applying this Bible verse (and Belief statements) to my life.
  - a. Share a personal story or experience related to this verse.
  - b. What does this verse say about my relationship to God?
  - c. How will this verse impact my life now and in the future?

Confessing what I believe – Essay and Presentation – using the information and ideas gathered, put together an essay (written) that will be shared (presentation) with other students, parents and members of St. John. Essays should be 2-3 pages typed (double spaced) and should take several minutes to present.

## **Essay Outline**

- I. Introduction
  - a. Introduce yourself.
  - b. Share what you believe about your faith using I believe statements
  - c. Introduce your Bible verse
- II. Body of the Essay
  - a. Explain your Bible verse
  - b. How does this verse "defend" or explain your beliefs?
  - c. How does this verse apply to your life?
  - d. share a personal story, experience or other meaningful event in your life.
- III. Conclusion
  - a. Summarize your verse and beliefs again.
  - b. How does what you believe impact your life now and in the future?
